

Waiver of Liability and Risk

The Firearm Safety Rules:

1. Assume every firearm is loaded.
2. Control the muzzle direction at all times.
3. Trigger finger off the trigger and out of trigger guard.
4. See that the firearm is unloaded. **PROVE** it safe.

Handling and discharging firearms and ammunition carries an inherent danger due to the contaminants and various toxins associated, the chance of debris, spalling, or ricochets, the potentially lethal consequences of an accidental or negligent discharge of the firearm, and further inadvertent injury that is possible from the manipulations of the mechanisms of the firearm.

To participate in this program, a user has the following understandings and agreements:

I understand that certain risks are inherent in the handling of firearms and ammunition. In participating in the training herein, I accept those risks. These risks include, but are not limited to, injury, disease, death, or damage to personal property.
